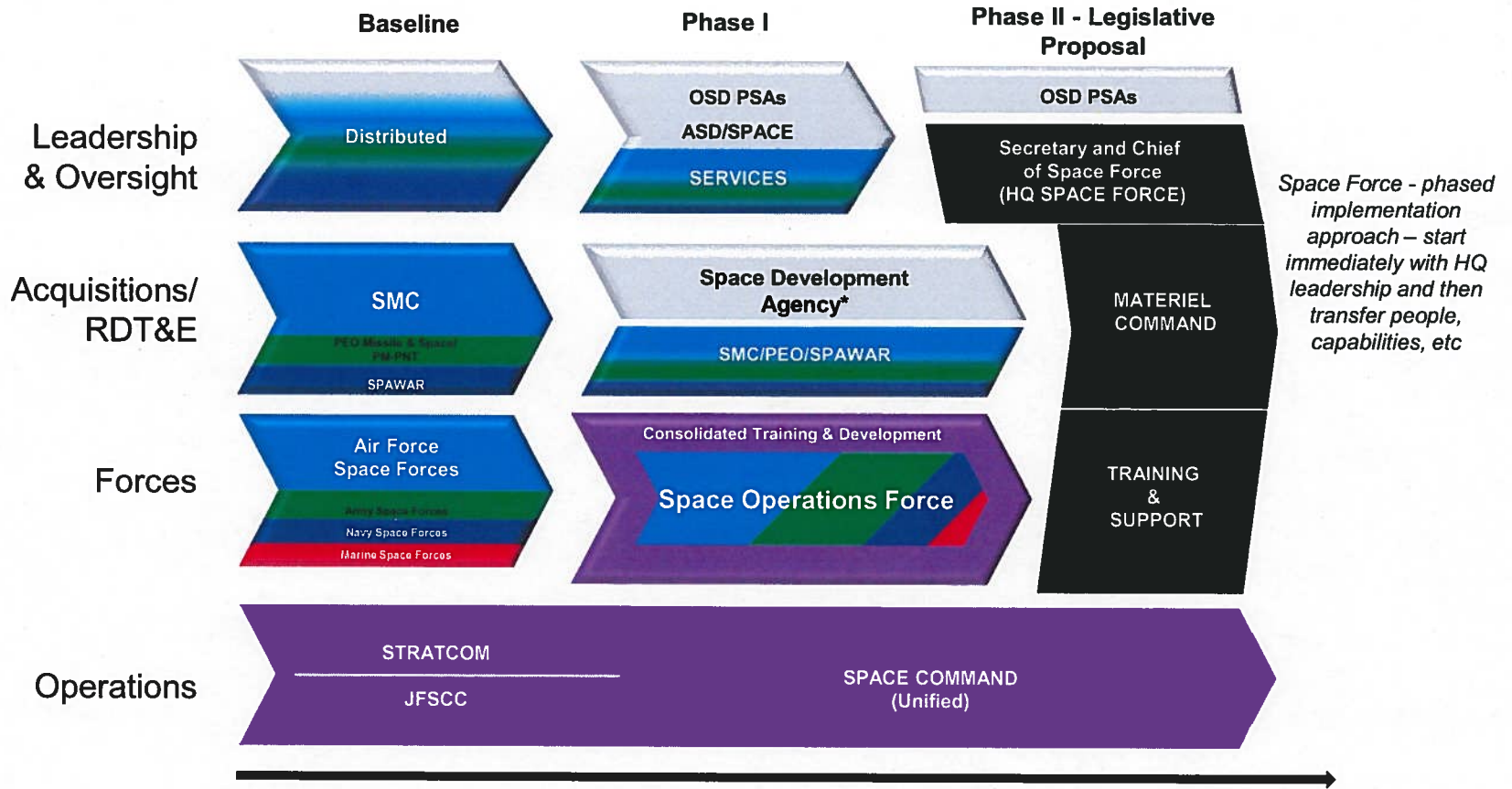

Space Force Proposal

- Proposed legislative bill language (submitted to Congress in February 2019)**
 - Changes to law
 - Explanatory text

- Budget request (submitted to Congress in February 2019)**
 - FY20 Budget & Out-year Implementation Plan

- Supporting analysis and key messages (supporting material for hearings, briefings, etc.)**
 - Details identifying what we would do with requested authorities and why we are requesting them
 - Defense Space Strategy to describe strategic imperative for creation of the Space Force and to meet intent of FY19 NDAA Section 1607 requirement to assess DoD space posture by March 2019



Legislative Proposal

□ Background / Comparison

- National Security Act of 1947 – 2.5 pages to establish USAF
- Title 10 U.S.C. Section D (U.S. Air Force) today – 150+ pages

□ Planned approach

- Clear and straightforward approach without prescribing unnecessary details
- Streamline Space Force functions and structures while maximizing warfighting effectiveness

□ Required Elements (examples)

- Section adding Subtitle to Title 10, U.S.C., for the Space Force
- Section amending Title 5, U.S.C., to set pay for Presidentially-appointed and Senate-confirmed officials (i.e., the Secretary, Under Secretary, Assistant Secretaries, and General Counsel)
- Section amending Title 10, U.S.C. 151 and 155 to add the Chief of Staff of the USSF to the JCS and provide for USSF members to be on JS
- Section authorizing transfer of resources (i.e., reprogramming funds and transferring personnel and equipment)
- One or more sections with various technical and conforming amendments
- USSPACECOM transition from Sub-Unified to Unified

Key Actions

- Determine mission, functions, and structure of the Department of the Space Force and USSF

Request necessary / essential authorities while maximizing Executive Branch flexibility
